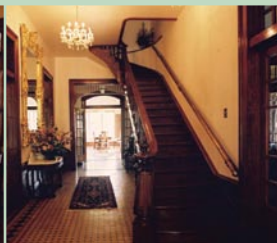


A Time to Reflect...

The ministry of Eternal Awakenings Christian Rehab Center resides in the “Hugh Lewis” mansion in historic Gonzales, Texas. The mansion, combined with the towering Oak trees and three acres of lawn, offers a place of serenity that is conducive to spiritual reflection. Fear and doubt are replaced by peace and serenity, furthering the healing process. Along with the natural beauty and tranquility of the Eternal Awakenings campus, the powerful anointing of God’s presence is undeniably real. New residents often tell us that from the moment they arrive powerful emotions begin to stir deep inside their hearts. Some residents who come on campus for the first time simply weep as they experience the glory of God’s presence. Prayer warriors across the country petition God for our residents and for our residents’ families.

To those who seek recovery through spiritual rejuvenation and restoration, the program at Eternal Awakenings is the first step to reclaim your life.



A Time to Heal...

*"... not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit, saith the Lord of hosts."
Zechariah 4:6 KJV*

The treatment program guides the addicted individual down his or her path of recovery that is inspired and empowered by the Holy Spirit. The fullness of the Holy Spirit is boldly manifested in our program because residents are taught the discipline of Prayer, Meditation and Bible Study.

In addition we incorporate other modalities of self discovery and divine intervention. Our residents report benefit from counseling that includes exploration of feelings; particularly feelings of guilt, shame, remorse and embarrassment. Feelings groups are painful for most residents and quickly open the door to the stark reality known as addiction.



The feelings group poignantly illustrates the need for God's redemption and forgiveness. In the group process, personal histories emerge and the healing presence of Jesus becomes real. At times, the stories of wreck and ruin seem overwhelming to all concerned. However, no matter how horrific the personal history, each person is God's creation and their inherent dignity is honored. Our residents are treated with the grace and respect demanded by the cross. No matter what modality or approach we might use, our efforts are rooted and stand firmly on Christ's message of restoration, redemption and reconciliation.

The message of Christian hope and reconciliation is taught by counselors who instruct through interactive didactic groups. A few of the topics which the residents are taught include: the Christian twelve steps, stress management from a biblical perspective, relapse prevention as spiritual warfare, communication skills within the family, victorious living despite addiction, the impact of addiction, the family, and the biology of addiction.



A Time to Heal continued...

The sharing of experiences between residents during free time, relieves the sense of isolation and alienation that is so strongly identified with addiction. Also, hope is highlighted when counselors and guest speakers share their personal stories that tell of the way out from the darkness of addiction into the light of God's deliverance.

Eternal Awakenings' intensive program is thirty days in length and operates ten to twelve hours a day Monday through Friday. After the entry level program, Eternal Awakenings offers a sixty and ninety day curriculum. To those who still need further assistance, help is provided through Continuing Care and Sober Living in a safe Christian environment for up to one year.



A Time for Compassion...

The majority of Eternal Awakenings' residents see consulting doctors on Tuesday of each week. Our residents may see an addiction physician or a psychiatrist depending on individual need. We believe our doctors tremendously increase the chances to achieve sobriety for our residents. The doctors help with general medical issues associated with addiction and are extremely effective with prescription drug addictions that are opiate based. Doctor visits are not covered in the cost of treatment. The initial evaluation is \$300.00 and each subsequent visit is \$150.00.

Experience Relaxation through Massage Therapy.

Our residents have the opportunity at least once a week to receive a massage. Massages are not covered in the cost of treatment.

Experience a State of the Art Recording Studio

The Eternal Awakenings Center is one hour from Austin, Texas, the live music capitol of the world. An unusually high number of Christian musicians attend our program. Experience the Fitness Center

Our residents have full access to a 14,000 square foot, state of the art fitness center. The fitness center has free weights, a variety of exercise machines, universal machines, bicycle machines, treadmill and elliptical cross trainer machines. In addition, the center offers fitness classes through Pilates, Competitive Gymnastics, Tae Kwon Do and boxing training. The fitness classes are not covered in the cost of treatment. Our residents have twenty four hour access to the fitness center seven days a week.

We also offer other recreational activities such as football, ping pong, basketball, horseshoes and swimming.

A Time to Worship...

In October 2005, a small group of recovering people met at a farm house near Gonzales, Texas to worship God through prayer, singing and discussion of God’s word. This small group was led by Jim and Karla Welch and would later become Living Waters Fellowship.

The congregation now worships in an historical building on the town square in Gonzales, Texas. The congregation is primarily composed of people who are in Christian recovery or who have family in Christian recovery.

Living Waters Fellowship is a church where the “secret” of addiction is a topic of candid discussion. No need to hide out because of fear that the residents’ addiction will be discovered. The church is a place where the addicted person is welcomed and accepted with open arms.

Many sermons by Pastor Jim or Karla address recovery issues from a Christian perspective.

The residents are often involved in the ministry of the church; particularly, the residents share their talent assisting in praise music.
